Israel Trip
Applying for FJA Funding**

Prior to applying for FJA funding, you need to provide written documentation that you have applied for all other sources of funding listed on the Israel trip application form.

No later than December 3, 2009, you must:

- Turn in the \$1,600 deposit

and/or

- Apply for FJA funding.

We expect the \$1,600 deposit to be paid by December 3, 2009, unless circumstances indicate the inability to pay this deposit. Please note that the \$1,600 deposit reserves your place on the trip.

If applying for funding without a deposit, we will hold off purchasing your flight ticket until collaboratively the business office and parents are confident the necessary funds are available. This way, if the necessary funding does not become available, you will not be responsible for a purchased flight ticket.

TO APPLY FOR FJA FUNDING, SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- A photocopy of the “Get There Fund” financial aid application, including the section for need-based funding.
- A signed, complete copy of the parent’s last 1040 income tax forms including schedules and W2’s.
 - If the 1040 income tax forms have been previously provided in FACTS for the 2009-2010 school year, you do not need to supply another copy.
 - The financial aid application and income tax forms, should be provided to Cynthia Baker in the business office.
